

Platte we journeyed to Sweetwater, then to Green river, which we forded by placing blocks under the wagon bed to raise it up to keep things inside dry. We camped one day near Fort Bridger, then on to Fort Hall. Captain Grant, of the Hudsons Bay Company, was in charge; he gave us the consoling information that the Indians would kill us before we got to Oregon; but they proved better than represented. We had little trouble with Indians, but they stole some things. We saw thousands of them, many in the same style as Adam and Eve when first in the garden of Eden. Next went to Fort Boise; Mr. Craig, of the I-ludsuns Bay Company, was in charge. He was more polite than Captain Grant; he only said we had better wait for more company, and he sent a French servant with a large canoe to take us women across Snake river, where we crossed it the second time. The men and teams forded it; then Bear river Burnt river, Malheur and Powder rivers, with their numerous Indian camps, were passed; the beautiful Blue mountains, Grand Ronde valley and river, then John Days river and next DesChutes or Fall river. This we had to ferry, the first since leaving the Missouri. There was a sand-storm raging; some Indians were there with their canoes who were more than willing to take us over for some calico shirts. The wagons were unloaded and taken...
