A condolence letter sent to a friend during a time of mourning, memorial tributes developed for Celebrations of Life, and spiritual poems written for the Holiday Season, reflect the central theme of the book. Love, Lee reminds us of the importance of expressing our love, appreciation and gratitude in writing, as a lasting legacy, to those we care about.
