There may be Ordovician strata on Seward Peninsula, as lot 1AC28 seems t have fragments of Illanus. However, the material is so fragmentary that m positive identification can be made, and the age of the strata in question is either Ordovician or Silurian. Lot 3AH51 (South Fork of Budd Creek) has a Syringopora different from other Seward Peninsula species and yet it may be of Silurian age. In 1900 some obscure fossils were collected by Mendenhall from the limestones at White Mountain, about 10 miles north of Golofnin Sound, which, though they could not be identified by paleontologists seemed to indicate either a Mesozoic or Tertiary age. In 1903 Hess made a thorough search for fossils on several low. rounded limestone buttes which stand as islands in the Quaternary deposits of the...
